SCOTCH THISTLE: Options for control

Key identifying traits • Stems are erect, branching, sharp spiny leaf wings extend down to the stem • Basal leaves may be over 2 feet long and a foot wide • Leaves are coarsely lobed, fine dense hair on both sides, with sharp spines on margin • Hairy leaf surface causes a grayish-green appearance • Flowers are pink to violet purple, 1 to 2
